Re: Open Records Request R031702-091326: This request concerns Georgia Procurement Registry event 46700-GDC0001150, "Modular Correctional Buildings," the request for information issued by the Department, opened March 4, 2025 and closed March 12, 2025, issuing officer Ross Barrineau.

On September 1, 2026 the Department responded to request R031447-090126 and produced the eRFI file together with a set of supplier documents. Our request in that case named a single company in its opening paragraph, so the production doesn't tell us whether the Department gathered everything it received or only the material from that company. This request asks one thing: who responded to the eRFI, and how many. We request:

Dear Mr. Bernard Christian:

The purpose of this correspondence is to respond to your Open Records Request received by the Department on September 13, 2026.

1. **Request:** All responses, submissions or materials the Department received in reply to eRFI 46700-GDC0001150, from any sender. If some of these were produced in R031447-090126, we're asking for anything from any other sender. A written statement that the earlier production was complete as to every sender would answer this item.

Response: The Department provided documents from Aries Building in response to this request. The Document containing floor plans have been redacted pursuant to O.C.G.A §50-18-72(25)(A)(i) "Security plans and vulnerability assessments for any public utility, technology infrastructure, building, facility, function, or activity in effect at the time of the request for disclosure or pertaining to a plan or assessment in effect at such time..."

2. **Request:** Records sufficient to show the number of responses the Department received to that eRFI and the identity of each respondent. A log, list, index, spreadsheet, receipt record or portal tracking entry would satisfy this item.

Response: The Department received responses from two suppliers to the RFI – ModCorr and Aries Buildings. The is the Department’s response to your question: If the Department received a response from only one supplier, we'd appreciate that said plainly.

3. **Request:** Any record evaluating, scoring, comparing, summarizing or ranking the responses received, and any resulting recommendation or memorandum.

Response: The Department has no documents responsive to this request. GSFIC handled the purchase and should have records responsive to this request.

4. **Request:** Any communication between the Department and a supplier, manufacturer or vendor concerning modular correctional buildings, from February 1, 2025 through May 31, 2025, other than the responses themselves.

Response: The Department has two documents responsive to this request. Documents Email Communications 1 and 2
